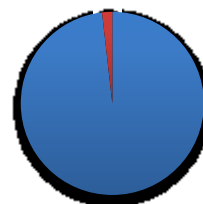
On Wednesday 14th January 2015 was the Gosford Hill School Parent Evening for Year 8. Below are highlights from the parents' and carers' survey:

My child makes good progress at this school



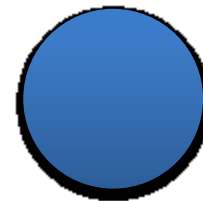
