

## **History KS4 AQA Syllabus A (SHP)**

This information is for students in year 9

Students will complete an introductory practice module of a breadth study of Crime and Punishment over time.

Then in term 3, students begin the course proper. There may be field work involved in the course, but there is no controlled assessment.

KS4 students are regularly assessed using past exam papers

Currently, the intention is for students to study...

- Crime and punishment through time – to practice GCSE skills
- Health through time – the health of Britain from the Middle Ages to the present day
- Depth study –America 1840-1895
- Depth study international conflict– either causes of World War 1 1875-1914, or the Cold War 1945-c1990
- A study of a local place in context - either Britain 1066-1087 or 1660-1685 including the study of an historical building
