Students celebrate their A* grades in Mathematics

A Level students at Gosford Hill School are celebrating their results in what has been another successful year. More than one eighth of all grades were A*, more than a quarter were A*/A and nearly a half at grade B or above.

Special congratulations to Beren Wilkinson on three A* grades, to Peter Fazekas and Simon Hague on A* A* A, to Aaron Long and Chester Wilkinson with A* A A, to Faye Brightmore with A* A* B and to Aaron Payne, Robert Sansom, Chloe Franklin and Charlotte Smith for achieving at least A A B. Beren will study Physics at Oxford University.

We are very pleased with our individual subject results. Mathematics had the highest number of entries and 67% of students achieved an A* grade. 60% of students in Applied Business and 43% in Further Mathematics achieved an A* grade. In Health and Social Care, 60% of students achieved double distinction star, equivalent to two A grades and in IT half of the students achieved distinction star (grade A).
